## **Hegarty Maths – New On-line Resource**

Due to feedback we have received from parents and pupils of the challenges faced when using Mymaths, we have decided to change our online learning platform to HegartyMaths from September. HegartyMaths has been designed by teachers for ease of use by pupils and feedback from schools that already use it has been very positive. The website has been carefully designed and structured to provide a learning tool to support pupils, teachers and parents. Every topic is accompanied by a video and practice questions based on the new curriculum up to and including GCSE.

With HegartyMaths, your child's teacher can see how long they have spent on the practice questions, how many times they have watched the video, how many times they have completed the questions, when they completed the questions, which questions they got wrong and what answer they put. In response to pupils' feedback from lessons and class work, each pupil can be set personalised tasks to address areas of need. If a pupil has an issue with completing the practice questions correctly then the teacher can set 'building blocks' to assist them in addressing the prerequisite skills.

Teachers and pupils can see an overview of their progress and, at a glance, see which areas are strong and which need more work. HegartyMaths can also be used to facilitate 'flipped learning,' enabling pupils to sharpen their skills in preparation for a lesson.

During this transition period, pupils will find that they are unable to log onto Mymaths, and since HegartyMaths will not be available for pupils to use until September, I would suggest the Corbettmaths website ([www.corbettmaths.co.uk](http://www.corbettmaths.co.uk)) as an alternative for revision during the summer holiday. Corbettmaths is free and requires no login details. It also contains thousands of maths videos, practice questions and solutions for every mathematics topic.
