For ages 4-11




Our activities will include:

Why choose us?

LJ Camp introduces your child to a world of musical discovery and imagination. During our week together, we will explore a variety of musical genres with a focus on both musical theatre and films. Each day we will visit a specific musical or film such as *Matilda* or *Beauty and the Beast*. Our sessions are designed to be fun and interactive where the focus is providing the most uplifting experience for each child in a safe environment.

The camp is run and led by Ian Lenihan and Julianne Jennings, both qualified teachers with a wealth of experience in music and drama. There will also be a minimum of two additional staff helping out on any given day, meaning the staff to student ratio is always low.

Our aim is to boost each child's confidence and self-esteem and each day will finish with a group session where the children show each other what they have discovered. The children will all have an opportunity to perform in a relaxed environment and all performers will receive a small prize.



Each day will start at 9:30am and finish at 4:00pm. Wrap around care is available and can be booked separately and drop off can be as early as 8:30am and pick-up right up to 5.00pm.

Sign up is on a day basis and is charged at £24 per child per day and £6 for the additional wrap-around care (£6 payable regardless of pick up times). Wrap-around can be booked in advance, or even on the day in circumstances where you might be running late.
