GEOGRAPHY FIELDWORK VISIT TO FLAMBOROUGH, WEDNESDAY 26th SEPTEMBER 2018

As part of their geography curriculum, pupils in Lower 4 are currently studying coastal processes and landforms. To promote a deeper understanding of the topics covered and the ability to apply the theories to reality, the Geography Department has organised a fieldwork visit to Flamborough Head and Mappleton on Wednesday 26th September 2018.

The pupils will travel to the coast by coach leaving Gateways after morning registration and returning at approximately 5.00 pm. Packed lunches will be provided.

Pupils should be dressed appropriately for all weather conditions. Sensible clothing includes: waterproofs in case of rain, warm, comfortable layers of clothing, stout footwear for walking and a waterproof day sack. Also, **wellingtons are compulsory**. Pupils should also bring a clipboard and a pencil and sun cream if necessary. It is important that anyone suffering from asthma should remember to bring her inhaler.
