GEOGRAPHY FIELDWORK VISIT TO HORNSEA, WEDNESDAY 5th JUNE 2019

As part of their geographical studies, pupils in Lower 5 will be studying Coasts. To promote a deeper understanding of the topics covered and the ability to apply the theories to reality, the Geography Department has organised a fieldwork visit to the Hornsea area on Wednesday 5th June 2019. It is crucial that students attend this fieldwork as the data gathered and fieldwork techniques utilised will be examined within their Geographical Applications paper, which is worth 30% of their final grade.

The pupils will travel to Hornsea in the school minibus, leaving Gateways at 8.45am and returning by the end of the school day. The school will provide a full packed lunch for the day.

Pupils should be dressed appropriately for inclement weather. Sensible clothing includes: waterproofs (jacket and trousers), warm layered clothing, wellingtons, stout footwear for walking and a waterproof day sack. A complete change of clothes (which can be left on the minibus during the day), is advisable, as the girls will be working in the sea with a high probability of getting wet. Pupils should also bring a clipboard and a pencil.

The cost of the visit will be £20.00. Please return the slip below to enable your daughter to take part in this very rewarding trip.
