Dear Parents

On Friday 3rd May the Tour de Yorkshire sees both the women's and men's races crossing areas close to Gateways. Many of you will have already seen the yellow notices in the local area warning of road closures. As in previous years, rolling road blocks will be in operation and will inevitably cause some traffic delays throughout the day.

The Stage 2 timetable is now available and shows that the men's race will pass through Shadwell and Alwoodley, along Wigton Lane and Alwoodley Lane, at around 4:00pm before moving on to Bramhope, Pool-in-Wharfedale and Harrogate.

Gateways will remain open throughout the school day with the school bus service operating as normal before and after school. Whilst there may be some traffic congestion in the local area for journeys to and from school, the school day itself will not be affected.

Please therefore collect your children at the end of the school day at their usual collection time. Homework Club and Sundowners will operate as normal until 6:00pm so if traffic congestion causes any travel delay on the way to school, children can make use of those facilities until such time as they are collected.
