**GEOGRAPHY FIELDWORK VISIT TO MALHAM, THURSDAY 13<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2019**

As part of their geographical studies, pupils in Upper 4 have been studying Rivers. To promote a deeper understanding of the topic and apply the theories that they have studied in class to the real world, the Geography Department has organised a fieldwork visit to Malham on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

The pupils will travel to Malham by coach, leaving Gateways at 8.45 am and returning at approximately 5.00 pm. The school will provide a full packed lunch for the day.

Pupils should be dressed appropriately for inclement weather. Sensible clothing includes: waterproofs (jacket and trousers), warm layered clothing, wellingtons, stout footwear for walking and a waterproof day sack. A complete change of clothes (which can be left on the coach during the day), is advisable, as the girls will be working in a river all day with a high probability of getting wet. Pupils should also bring a clipboard and a pencil. The Field Centre staff leading the activity are fully qualified in Outdoor Studies and hold First Aid Certificates.

The cost of the visit will be £30. Please return the slip below to enable your daughter to take part in this very rewarding trip.
