We used a variety of techniques such as random and systematic sampling to test out two hypotheses about the effects of groynes on the beach. In addition, pupils were able to visualise one of our examination case studies.

The class worked brilliantly within their groups to gather both quantitative and qualitative data and, after several years of Covid restrictions, it was additionally nice to be able to return to the technique of questionnaires.
