

3D graffiti trainers



As part of the 3D design carousel Upper 4 have been creating their own graffiti inspired tags which they will be using to create a 3D graffiti themed trainer inspired by the work of Michael Leavitt.

This week pupils have been learning how to create digital designs using Photoshop and have learnt how to layer their designs using techniques such as the magic wand tool, rectangular marquee tool and eraser tool to transfer and adapt existing designs from the internet onto a trainer outline. Pupils have also learnt how to create graffiti tags using bars and have added relevant shapes and colours to create an eye-catching design using posca pens which they will be transferring onto digital nets to create their own 3D trainer!
