

Lower 6 Sociology carry out research into gender and education



All our Sociology pupils worked really hard during lockdown. The Lower Sixth enjoyed some variation on our screen free day when they carried out their own research project. They asked 20 male and female pupils about their experiences of school using questionnaires with a standard list of questions distributed through social media.

We enjoyed discussing their findings which were similar to what we have been learning about in the gender and education topic. It was interesting to note that boys reported spending less time on their work than girls and feeling confident in their abilities and that girls seemed to spend more time and were more anxious to do well in their work than boys. This reflects what we have found in the sociology we have studied.
