

Here are their all-time favourites voted for on World Book Day - from early childhood through to their current reading. Those with several votes each are shown at the top of the list.


Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban (JK Rowling)

Here are their all-time favourites voted for on World Book Day - from early childhood through to their current reading. Those with several votes each are shown at the top of the list.


