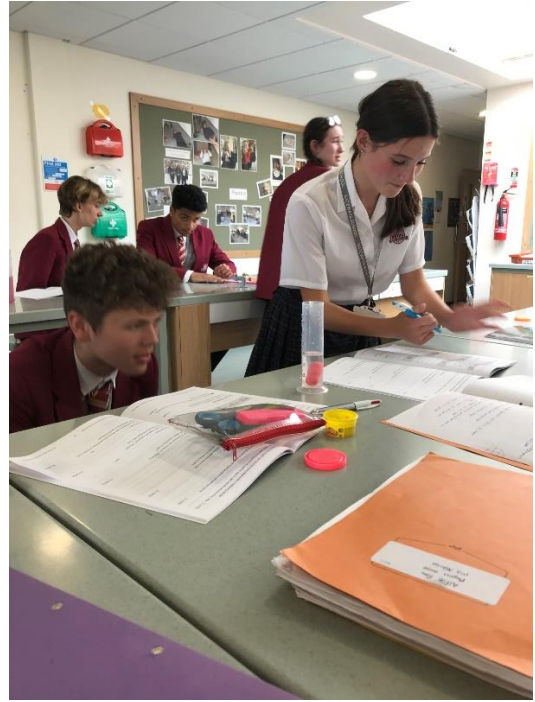


Upper 4 pupils start their GCSE physics required practicals
