
## **High School & Sixth Form**

In 3D design Lower 5 have been developing their technical drawing skills as part of their architecture project this term. Pupils have started creating designs for a building inspired by the artists/architects Theo Van Doesberg and Gerrit Rietveld and have been inspired by their use of abstraction, simplified rectilinear geometry and use of primary colours. We have started with collages demonstrating their understanding of colour use in a grid format and used single point perspective to protrude shapes out into a three dimensions projection.

Pupils have learnt how to use horizon lines, vanishing points and converging lines to create accurate drawings of their ideas which moving forward, will be developed using computer aided design.
