Jessica Grady's textile work is a bold and tactile exploration of colour and pattern through hand stitching and embellishment. She produces patterns for print, exhibits all over the country and has even worked for Alexander McQueen and Givenchy.

This week we had her in to deliver an embroidery workshop to our Lower 5 textiles students. They learnt how to make their own recycled sequins, how to use found materials like sponge, lids, straws and wire to use as embellishments and learnt different stitched construction methods to make a 3D abstract coral reef for their seascapes project.
