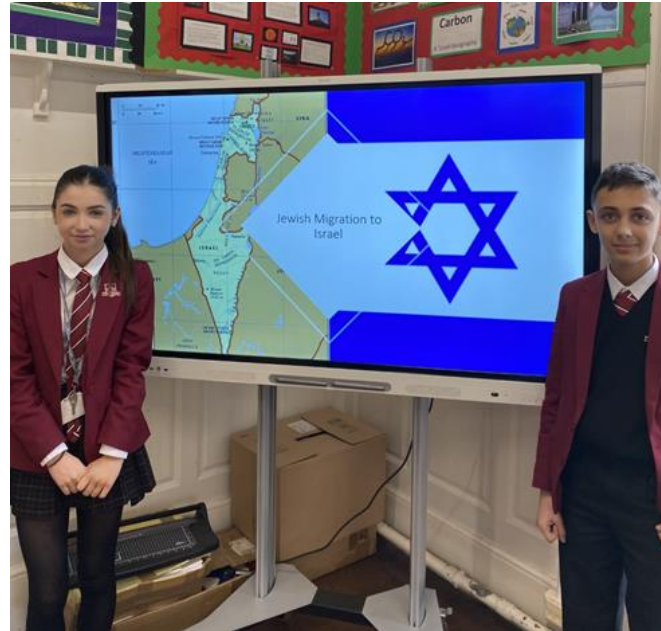


Lower 4 geographers study migration
