

#### **Details**

This competition is free to enter.

Each entrant can submit only one drawing or painting into the competition. We encourage entrants to enter scans of their drawing or painting rather than photographs. Entrants should keep hold of their original drawing or painting as this may be requested at a later date.

The competition will close for entries at 23:59 BST on 29th July 2023. Winning entries will be announced on the RSB's website in October 2023.

#### **Prizes**

There are three age categories (7-11, 12-14, and 15-18) and prizes are awarded for:

- a winner (£50 for the student) to be awarded to a young person from anywhere in the World
- **a UK based winner** (£50 for the student) to be awarded to enable this competition to recognise the artwork of children living in the UK

- a highly commended runner up (£20 for the student) to be awarded to a young person from anywhere in the World
- a winner of the new Nancy Rothwell Prize 2023 (£50 for the student) to be awarded as a specific named specimen drawing prize (The Nancy Rothwell Prize 2023) to recognise specimen drawing in schools and to highlight the benefits of combining art and science

All highly commended entrants and winners will be invited to an online experience day at the **Royal Veterinary College**.
