2022 winner: theme 'communication'

Each year the Royal Society of Biology opens up competitions for those pupils that are enthused by science. The Royal Society of Biology Photography Competition is now open for entries! The first competition is the Young Photographer of the Year and this year the theme is nature and climate.

Life on Earth is affected by the climate, weather and seasonal changes and this year we invite you to capture this. Your photograph could depict and capture the story of life as it is affected by the climate, weather or seasonal changes, perhaps in an unexpected or changed environment, or showing how the natural world is affected by a changing climate (and weather patterns). We also welcome entries that explore this year's theme at the molecular or cellular level, illustrating the affects or changes in nature and climate via processes only revealed to us with the aid of a microscope.

The details

- Each entrant may enter **up to three** photographs into the competition.
- Images should be high resolution JPEG or PNG files and no larger than 10MB in size.
- Entrants must fill in all sections of the entry form.
- Please read the competition's full [terms and conditions](#) before entering and submitting your photographs.
- Photographers are requested to consider their own welfare and that of other individuals and they take care in their attempt get their photographs. Past photographs can be submitted into the competition.

All entries must have consent from a parent/guardian before entering this competition.
