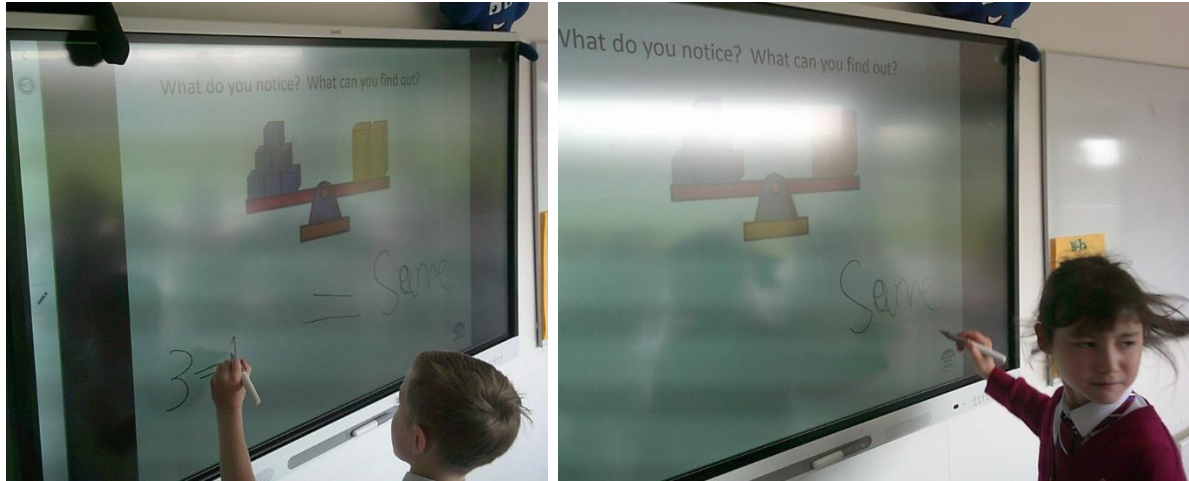


The mass of different objects



In Upper 1, the children decided if an object was heavier or lighter by using balance scales. They used units of measure to work out which object was heavier or lighter. Understanding that kilograms are heavier than grams will help them to compare mass, for example 100g is lighter than 100kg. They also compare using fractions: for example, $\frac{1}{2}$ kg is heavier than 400g.
