

Royal Society of Biology - drawing competition



Each year the Royal Society of Biology opens up competitions for those pupils that are enthused by science.

The Royal Society of Biology the BioArtAttack (2D) competition is now open for entries!

This 2023 competition is a new drawing and painting competition for children aged 7-18 years old to draw or paint their favourite animal, plant or fungi. This competition celebrates and highlights the benefits of combining art and science. More information has been provided in the form of a PowerPoint which can be accessed here.

The finer details

This competition is free to enter.

Each entrant can submit only one drawing or painting into the competition. We encourage entrants to enter scans of their drawing or painting rather than photographs. Entrants should keep hold of their original drawing or painting as this may be requested at a later date.

The competition will close for entries at midnight on 29th July 2023. Winning entries will be announced on the RSB's website in October 2023.

Prizes

There are three age categories (7-11, 12-14, and 15-18) and prizes are awarded for:

- a winner (£50 for the student) to be awarded to a young person from anywhere in the World.
- **a UK based winner** (£50 for the student) to be awarded to enable this competition to recognise the artwork of children living in the UK.

- a highly commended runner up (£20 for the student) to be awarded to a young person from anywhere in the World.
- a winner of the new Nancy Rothwell Prize 2023 (£50 for the student) to be awarded as a specific named specimen drawing prize (The Nancy Rothwell Prize 2023) to recognise specimen drawing in schools and to highlight the benefits of combining art and science.

All highly commended entrants and winners will be invited to an online experience day at the **Royal Veterinary College**.

If you would like to enter this competition and would like some support with the theme or ideas, please speak to your science teachers and your art teachers. Your form tutor would also be interested to know that you are entering this competition.

The competition will close for entries at midnight on 29th July 2023. Winning entries will be announced on the RSB's website in October 2023.
