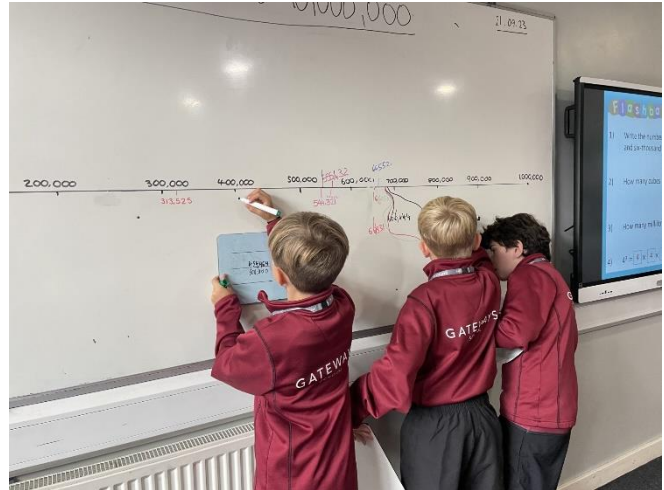
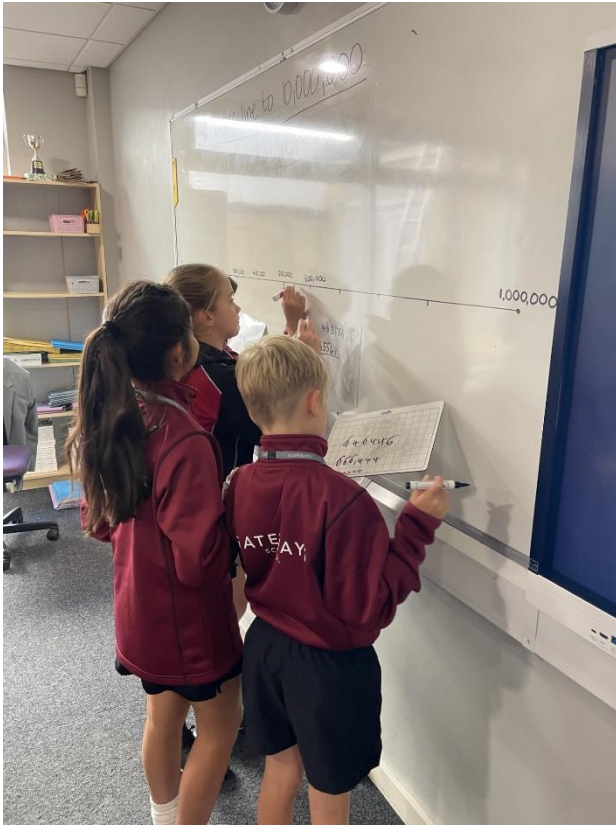


Fun with numbers to 1,000,000
