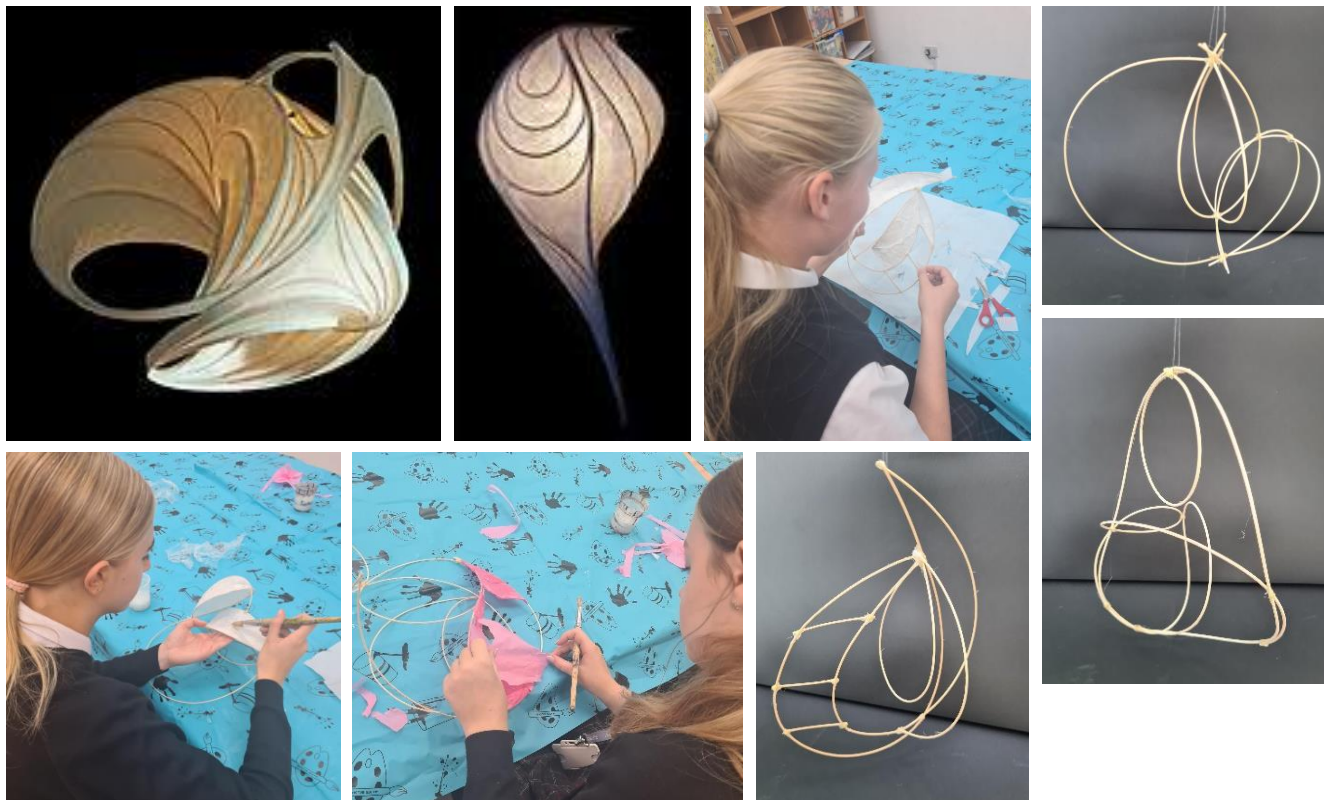


Lower 5 light sculptures



In 3D design Lower 5 have been creating light sculptures inspired by the designer William Lesley. William Lesley has developed a unique form of light sculpture made from thin strips of wood bent into a frame and covered in polyvinyl resin. Most of Lesley's designs are inspired by natural forms. Lower 5 have taken inspiration from shells as a starting point and created some impressive designs, before working with thin cane and tissue paper to create their own abstract and organic shapes. This project is designed to test their problem-solving skills and develop their resilience when manufacturing; there are some impressive outcomes emerging.
