

Lower 6 textiles - cartography



In art textiles our lower 6 students have been using a variety of techniques and materials including photoshop, applique, fabric printing and machine stitching to develop ideas for their theme of 'Cartography.' They have been studying the work of Valerie Goodwin who is a mixed media fibre artist and architect. Most of her work is inspired by a love of aerial views of landscapes and cities and many of her quilts are based on maps.

Students have been drawing their own maps and have scanned these in order to layer and edit digitally on photoshop. These will then be heat transferred onto fabric for them to stitch, quilt and embellish further by hand. See below for some of their outcomes.
