

Upper 3 DT - block animals



Upper 3 have been designing and making a wooden block animal during their design technology lessons. They have been learning how to accurately use marking out and cutting tools to manufacture their animal with a focus on health and safety in the workshop. As part of this project pupils have learnt how to accurately use a steel rule and try square to mark out their wood, a tenon saw to cut and a belt sander to sand and shape. Pupils have learnt about sustainable material choices and have been given freedom to add features to their animals using off-cuts of materials and nails.
