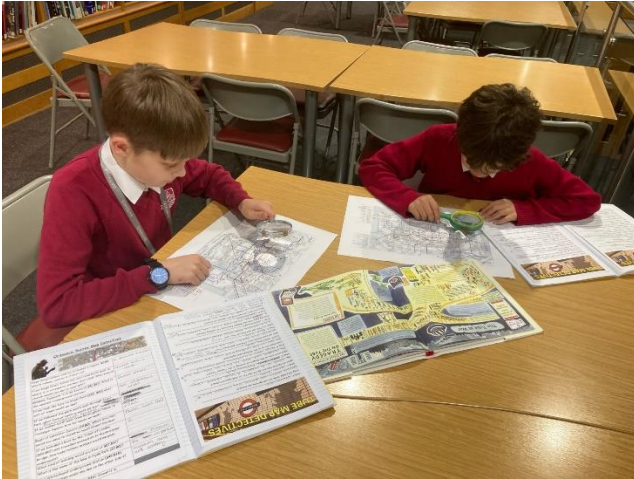


Lower 3 - Tube map detectives
