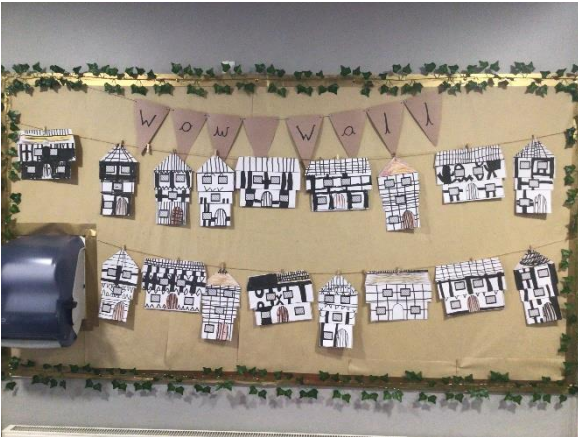


## Making tudor houses
