

Upper 4 pupils meet Dr Volcano



To kickstart Science Week, Upper 4 pupils enjoyed an engaging visit from Dr Volcano last Friday. During the visit, Dr Volcano shared insights with the pupils on various types of volcanic eruptions. Using simple ingredients such as milk and food colouring, Dr Volcano demonstrated how lava flows from the crater onto the surrounding land.

A particular highlight for the Upper 4 pupils was the exploration of the differences between obsidian rocks and pumice stones, focusing on their unique abilities to either sink or float in water, respectively. This observation cleverly led to discussions about possible explanations for how organisms might have survived long journeys across vast oceans.

It was an enriching and educational experience that captivated the students and contributed to their understanding of geological phenomena.
