Plant dissections in Upper 1



This half term, Upper 1 are learning all about plants!

In our last lesson, we enjoyed dissecting some plants to allow us to look closely at the different parts. The children separated the plants into the; roots, stems, leaves and flowers. We then closely inspected each part – finding out what was hidden inside buds, and cutting into the stems to see what was inside (a cool, jelly-like substance in something that looked a bit like celery!).
