

Upper 3 Spanish share their revision strategies



Upper 3Y have been discussing their preferred revision techniques and strategies in their Spanish lessons this week.

We shared lots of different ideas such as using mnemonics and creating chain stories to remember a sequence of information. Some pupils spoke about creating flashcards, labelling diagrams and making mind maps to display their revision in a more visual way.

Some pupils explained how they preferred doing practice questions so that they could check their understanding of a certain topic and identify areas to work on themselves. After completing a mixture of practice questions in small groups, pupils could identify where they needed to focus their revision time.

The pupils had great ideas to share and it was lovely to hear them explain their strategies so well.

It has been a good opportunity for pupils to take time to think carefully about which strategies have worked well for them in the past and which ones they would like to try out whilst preparing for their upcoming test week.
