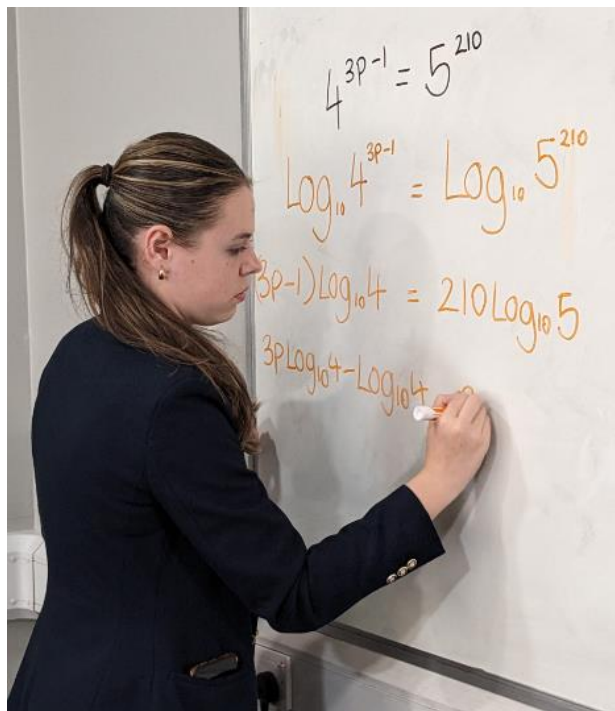


Peer teaching in Lower 6
