

Art residential: 3D Design



This past weekend a group of Lower 5 and Upper 5 GCSE pupils went to Conway residential centre in Wales to participate in a variety of different workshops based on the theme 'Mapping the Landscape'. 3D Design pupils worked extremely hard making sculptures focusing on the natural contours of the human body and the landscape. They were encouraged to consider links between dress patterns and maps of Wales and used collage and lines to connect markings and roads to link their work together. Pupils focused on sculptures by the artists Naum Gabo, Derek Lerner, Peter Gentenaar and Barabara Hepworth to influence 3D shapes made from wire and tissue paper to create further links in their work.
