Lower 5 religious studies pupils consider how best to punish criminals



As part of their GCSE Religious Studies, Lower 5 have been researching and producing presentations on the advantages and disadvantages of different forms of punishment for criminals including prison, corporal punishment, victim-offender mediation and community service.
