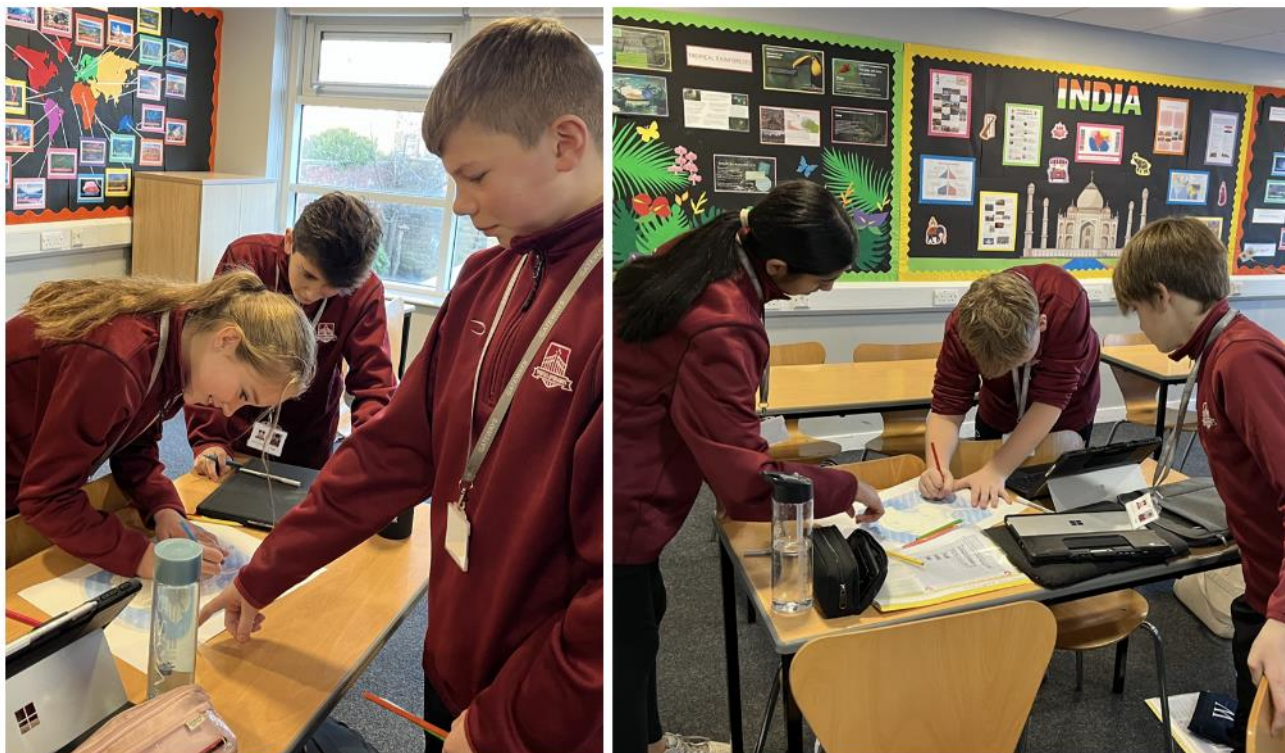


Upper 3 geographers get active about Antarctica



Our Upper 3 geographers have started learning about Antarctica this half term and have already had a lot of fun in the process.

This week, we learned about the location of the continent and its major features on a map by playing a game of maps from memory. Working in groups, each member had 20 seconds at a time to view a completed map of Antarctica that they then had to recreate in their teams.

We then followed this with a game of “collect the fact” with features dotted around the room that needed adding to a blank base map.

Finally, we played a game of “pick up the penguin” where pupils raced to use geographical terms within a sentence in exchange for a penguin for their team.

There was a lot of laughter within the lesson and pupils really showed good progress in terms of their knowledge of geographical features, proving that learning really can (and should) be fun!
