## Upper 3 acids and alkalis







In Upper 3 chemistry lessons the pupils have started a new topic on the reactions of acids and alkalis. There are lots of experiments in this topic so the pupils have had fun testing everyday products to see if they are acid or alkali, and have been testing the strength of different acids.
