

## Lower 2 - amazing science





Lower 2 have been learning about some amazing science topics over the last few weeks. Firstly, we finished off our topic on electricity. The children have loved designing and making different electrical circuits, making buzzers buzz or light bulbs shine. Some of the children were able to make their tiny, coloured bulbs light up!
