Sixth Form geographers explore Leeds



This term, the Lower 6 geographers have been investigating how places change over time. Their studies focused on Leeds, examining its transformation from an 18th-century global centre of textile manufacturing to a modern hub for financial services. As part of their fieldwork, pupils visited areas undergoing regeneration through the South Bank initiative — a major redevelopment project aimed at revitalising parts of the south bank of the River Aire, including Holbeck, which had experienced industrial decline. They also explored the new Climate Innovation District and conducted environmental surveys to support their understanding of sustainable urban development.
