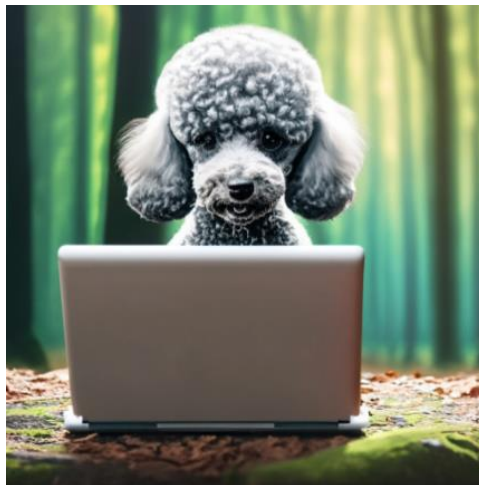


## What will the future hold?
