However, she discovers her passion for law and proves her worth by successfully defending exercise queen Brooke Wyndham in a murder trial. The show is known for its themes of self-discovery, empowerment, and challenging stereotypes.

Ella is working on 'The wizard of Oz'. A classic tale follows Dorothy as she is swept away to the magical land of Oz.
