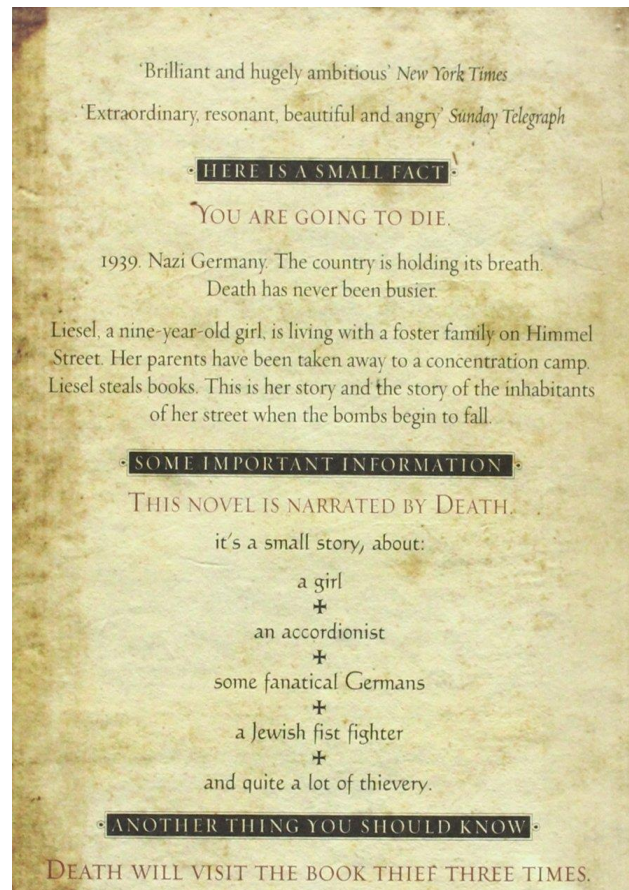
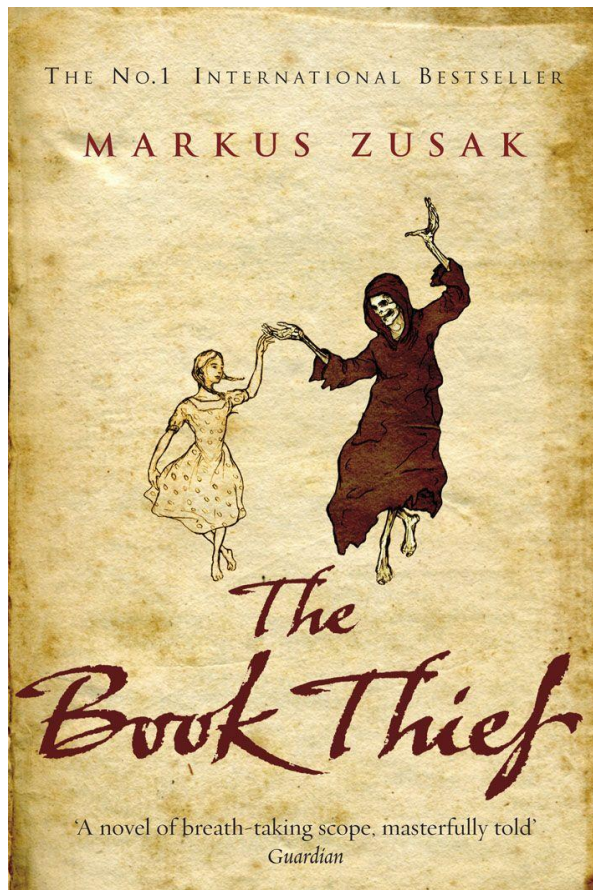


English Literature, History, and PSHE combine through Upper 4's exploration of 'The Book Thief'
