Important School Information

- International Students

The admissions process is:

1. Register (assessment fee £250)
2. Arrange an online interview with the Head or Deputy Head
3. Assessments/references
4. Offer letter (including terms and conditions)
5. Commitment fee
(payment of the first terms fees)
6. Production of CAS (Certificate of Studies)
(A child's place is only confirmed at step 5)

Prep School

After your initial online interview, your child will be assessed upon entry into the UK. They will meet key staff members in person and have a tour of Gateways School.

Senior School

Applicants for Senior School will have an online interview and will then be required to complete an online Entrance Assessment at their current school. This online test allows us to assess a pupil's current academic ability.

Sixth Form

A minimum of five GCSE grades 9 to 4 or the equivalent is normally required for entry. In subjects an applicant wishes to study for A Level, their predicted GCSE grades in that subject (or other relevant subjects) should be at grade 7 or above. There is an online admission interview for all candidates.

Attendance

See the website for details of the school day. Parents are asked not to arrange holidays for pupils during term time and to notify the school if absence is required for medical reasons. All absences are recorded.

Safeguarding

Gateways is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all children and our staff and volunteers share this commitment.



Pastoral Support

We place a strong emphasis on pastoral care, especially for our international pupils who may be adjusting to a new environment, culture, and educational system. Pupils are supported by a dedicated pastoral lead for each key stage, who works closely with teaching staff to ensure a smooth transition and ongoing wellbeing. We provide a nurturing and inclusive atmosphere where every pupil feels valued, safe, and supported. Regular check-ins and a strong sense of community help international students settle in quickly and thrive both academically and personally.

Transport

Gateways School operates a transport service which covers Leeds and the surrounding area. This includes Wetherby, Shadwell, Alwoodley, Headingley, Adel, Bramhope, Roundhay, Horsforth, Collingham, Boston Spa and Harrogate.
